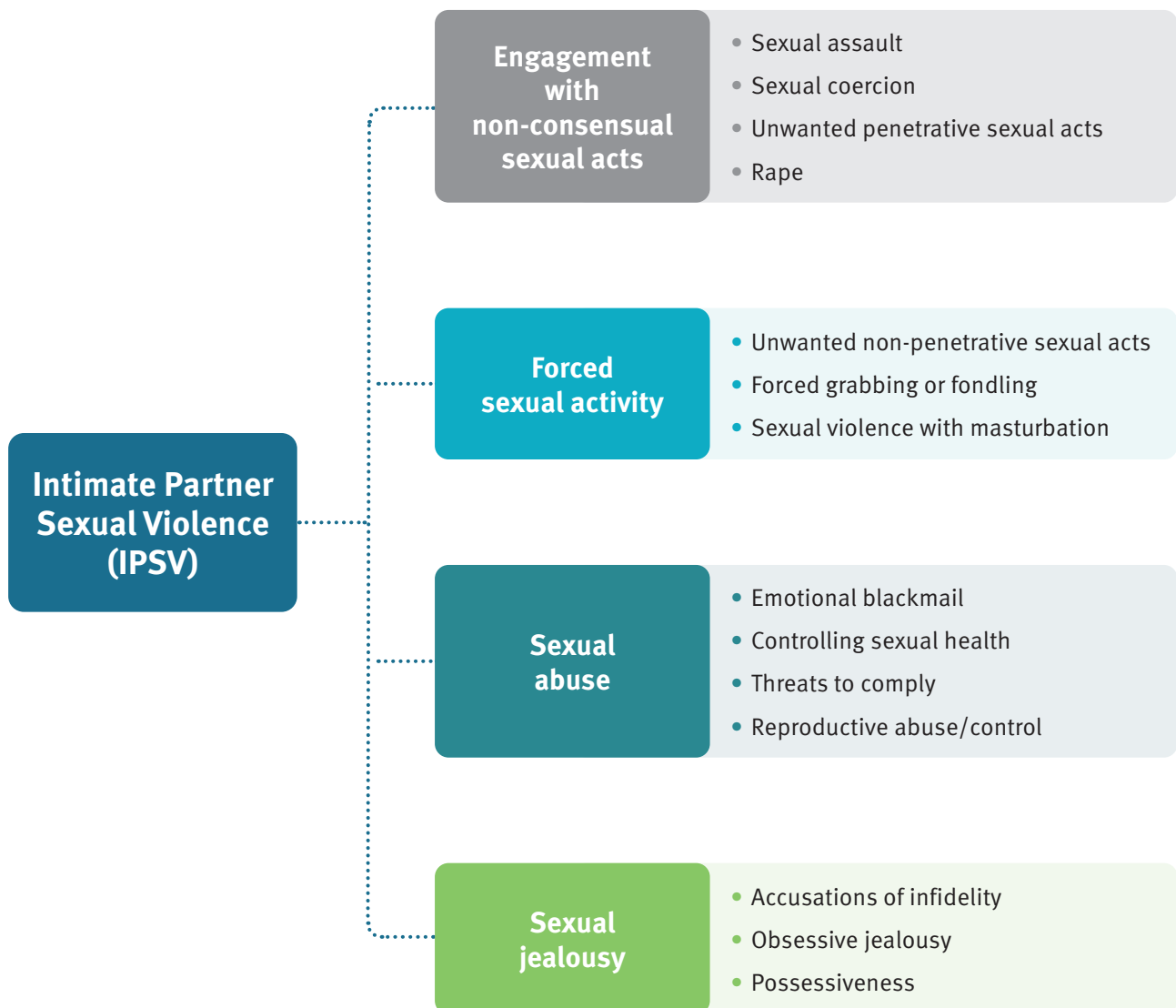


Sexual violence
